6.2.1. GENERAL

Lifeline service provides a reduction in the monthly rate for the provision of local residential service for qualified customers.

6.2.2. REGULATIONS

- A. Lifeline service is available only to qualified customers who meet the following requirements:
 - 1. Applicant must meet the requirements of a state established income test.
 - 2. Applicant must not be a dependent for federal income tax purposes, unless applicant is more than 60 years of age.
 - 3. Applicant must be eligible for or receiving assistance from a low income assistance or energy assistance program administered by the Department of Income Maintenance and Human Resources, or eligible for or receiving Supplemental Security Income from the Social Security Administration. The list of qualifying programs will be maintained by the Department of Public Utility Control
- B. Lifeline service applies only for a single telephone line for the principal residence of the eligible applicant.
- C. The Company will provide Lifeline service only with the Local Only Offer, as specified in Section 6.1.2.
- D. Lifeline service customers will pay a reduced monthly recurring charge for a local access line. The customer may subscribe to standard features and services at the applicable rates, charges and regulations for each feature and service provided. Premium services offered by the Company will not be available.
- E. Lifeline service will be provided to a customer only so long as such customer continues to meet the Company's participation and certification guidelines.
- F. Lifeline service customers are subject to all residential service regulations in this and other Tariffs of the Company.
