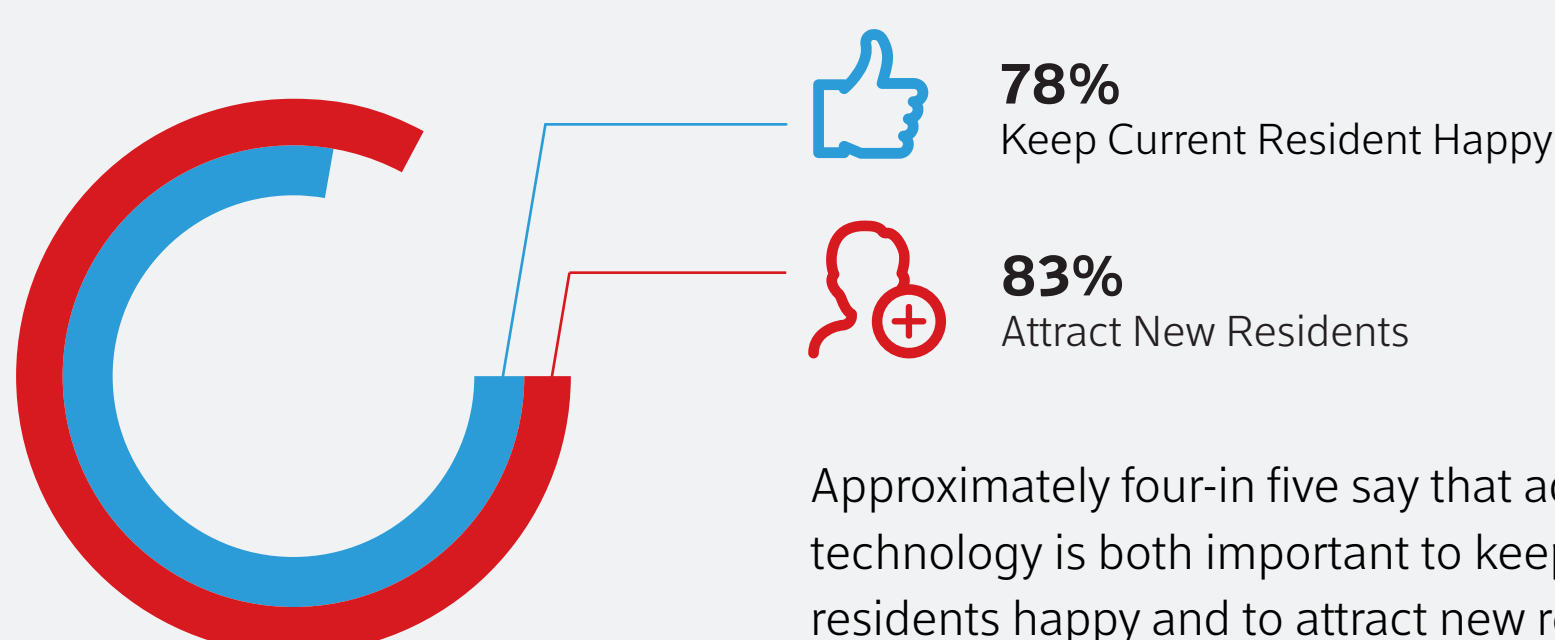


The State of Smart Technology in the Multifamily Housing Industry

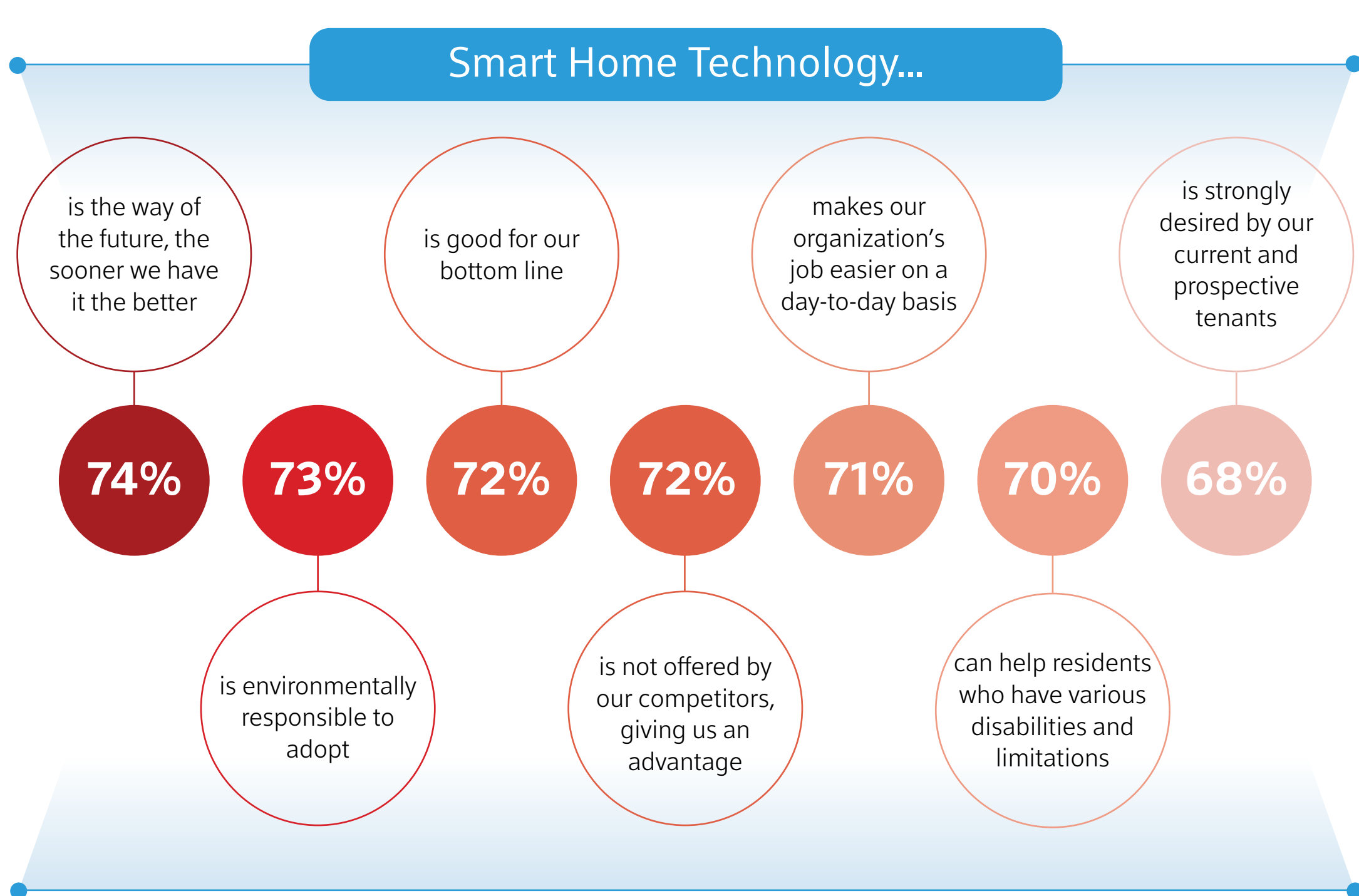

Considerations for Implementing Smart Home Technology

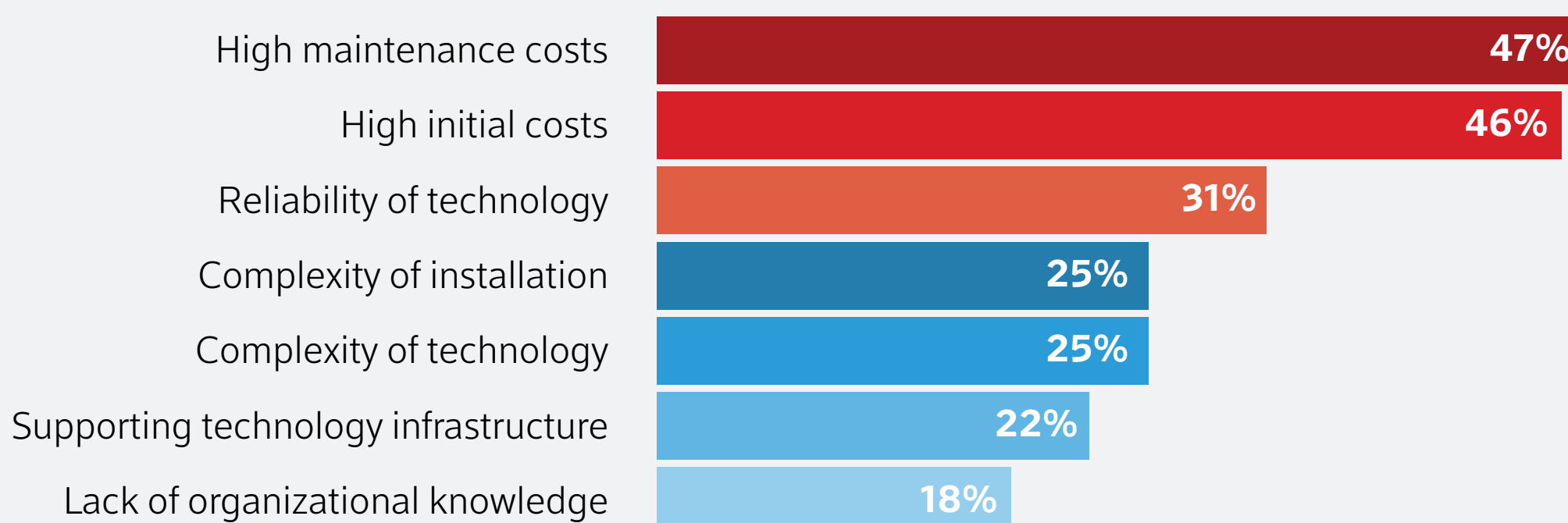
Over 70% of organizations say that the adoption of smart home technology is the way of the future, environmentally responsible, and good for their bottom line.
