



<u>Interconnected VoIP Service</u>: An interconnected VoIP service is a service that (i) enables real-time, two-way voice communications; (ii) requires a broadband connection from the user's location; (iii) requires internet protocol-compatible customer premises equipment (CPE); and (iv) permits users generally to receive calls that originate on the public switched telephone network and to terminate calls to the public switched telephone network.

<u>Interstate Communications</u>: The term "Interstate Communications" applies to the regulatory jurisdictions of services used for communications between locations located in different states within the United States or between one or more locations in the United States and one or more international locations.

<u>Intrastate Communications</u>: The term "Intrastate Communications" denotes any communications within the state subject to oversight by a state regulatory commission as provided by the laws of the state involved.

<u>Joint User</u>: A person, firm or corporation designated by the Customer as a user of switched access or interconnection facilities furnished to the Customer by the Company, and to whom a portion of the charges for such facilities are billed under a joint use arrangement.

<u>Local Access Transport Area (LATA)</u>: A local access and transport area established pursuant to the Modification of Final Judgment entered by the United States District Court for the District of Columbia in Civil Action No. 82-9192 for the provision and administration of communications services.


<u>Local Calling Area</u>: A geographical area, as defined in the Company's exchange telecommunications service tariff in which an end user may complete a call without incurring toll usage charge.

 \underline{MRC} : - Monthly Recurring Charge: A fixed charge that applies each month during which service is provided to the Customer.

1.3. **DEFINITIONS (CONT'D)**

(C) Recurring Charges: The monthly charges for the Customer for services, facilities and equipment, which continue for the agreed upon duration of the service. Service Commencement Date: The first day following the date on which the Company notifies the Customer that the requested service or facility is available for use, unless extended by the Customer's refusal to accept service which does not conform to standards set forth in the Service Order or this tariff, in which case the Service commencement Date is the date of the Customer's acceptance. The parties may mutually agree on a substitute Service Commencement Date. <u>Service Order (or "Sales Order")</u>: The written request for services executed by the Customer and the Company in the format devised by the Company. Services: The Company's telecommunications switched access and interconnection services offered by the Company. Shared: A facility or equipment system or subsystem which can be used simultaneously by several Customers. (C) Signaling System 7 (SS7): The common channel out of Band Signaling protocol developed by the Consultative Committee for International Telephone and Telegraph (CCITT) and the American National Standards Institute (ANSI). (C) Tandem Transport: The term "Tandem Transport" denotes the transport between (C) an access tandem and the Company's End Office, Trunk Gateway or other functionally equivalent location. (C) Trunk: A communications path connection two switching systems in a network. Trunk Gateway: The point of interface between the PSTN trunk facility and the (C) Company defined by Common Language Location Identifier (CLLI) codes assigned to the Company, as reflected in the Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG). Services provided at a Trunk Gateway location are the functional equivalent of services provided at an End Office location. (\mathbf{C})
