#### **3.1 CONNECTION CHARGES**

#### **3.1.1 GENERAL**

Connection Charges are nonrecurring charges which applies to the following: (a) the installation of a new service; (b) the transfer of an existing service to a different location; (c) a change from one class of service to another at the same or a different location; or (d) restoral of service after suspension or termination for nonpayment.

#### **3.1.2 EXCEPTIONS TO THE CHARGE**

The Company may from time to time waive or reduce the charge as part of a promotion. See Section 5.2.

## **3.3** MOVES, ADDS AND CHANGES

- **3.3.1** The Company alone may make changes in the location of its lines and equipment. When it is found that a move or change of such lines or equipment has been made by others, the Connection Charge for the underlying service will apply as if the work had been done by the Company.
- **3.3.2** The customer will be assessed a charge for any move, add or change of a Company service. Move, Add and Change are defined as follows:

Move - the disconnection of existing equipment at one location and reconnection of the same equipment at a new location in the same building or in a different building on the same premises.

Add - The addition of a vertical service to existing equipment and/or service at one location.

Change – Change including rearrangement or reclassification -of existing service at the same location. Also includes a change of the customers' Intra-LATA or Inter-LATA Primary Interexchange Carrier (PIC).
